Application Process

- 1. Practitioners will be required to submit their application via the link on the Centre for Advancing Practice website
- 2. Practitioners who meet the minimum eligibility criteria will be invited to start preparing their portfolio on the Centre Portal in readiness for their Learning Needs Analysis
- 3. Those unsuccessful at this point are advised to talk to their line managers or regional faculty leads
- 4. Practitioners will be notified when they are matched to an Education Provider (EP) and who their ePortfolio Assessor will be
- 5. The ePortfolio Assessor will arrange a Learning Needs Analysis interview
- 6. Following the Learning Needs Analysis, individuals will be informed of the outcome of their application

Applications for the ePortfolio Route will be prioritised according to the Centre's nationally agreed allocations and the limitations set.

Eligibility Criteria
